

## Adjectives ending on –ed and –ing

(pridevniki, ki se končajo na –ed in –ing)

<b>-ED</b>	<b>-ING</b>
<b>describe one's own feeling</b> (Nanaša se na ljudi in označuje njihova čustva.)	<b>describe people, things or situations that cause one's feeling</b> (Nanaša se na ljudi, stvari ali situacije, ki povzročajo neka čustva.)
surprised	surprising
shocked	shocking
interested	interesting
confused	confusing
annoyed	annoying
bored	boring
worried	worrying
frightened	frightening
excited	exciting
embarrassed	embarrassing
disappointed	disappointing

### Example:

I'm **bored**. / I feel **bored**. = Dolgočasim se.

The film is **boring**. = Film je dolgočasen in je vzrok mojega čustva.

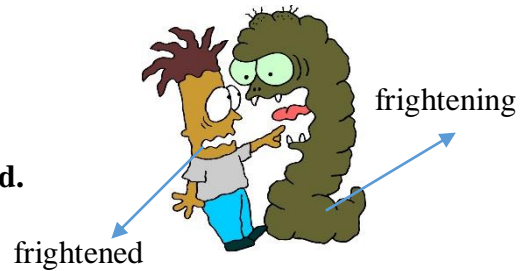


Our boss was **so boring** at the meeting last night, therefore we were **bored**.

I'm **frightened**. / I feel **frightened**. = Strah me je./ Prestrašen sem.

He is **frightening**. = On je zastrašujoč, strašljiv in s tem vzrok mojih čustev.

The monster was so **frightening**, so I felt **frightened**.



He is **annoyed**. = On je znerviran, jezen.

He is **annoying**. = On je zoprn, nadležen in povzroča neprijetno počutje.

He was so **annoying** the other day and I felt totally **annoyed**.
